









★ THE GAME

The most creative player plays first. (If you cannot decide, the youngest one starts). On your turn, you have to get the other players to guess an enigma. To do this, you must:

- 1 Take an Enigma card. Another random player calls out a number between 1 and 8 which tells you which enigma on the card has to be guessed.
 - If you do not know this enigma you can take the next one down or the one above (for line 1 you can choose between 8 or 2 and for line 8, between 7 and 1).

Note: For younger players they can choose from any other enigma on the card.





3 Get the other players to guess your enigma by placing all the transparent cards equired in the playing area. You can spread them out, move them around, put them together or on top of each other however you like to make it as easy as possible for the other players to guess.

Everything is possible with the transparent cards and any means can be used to make yourself understood (see the examples on the following pages)

OBut you cannot:

- speak or make noises
- spell out a letter or a digit
- mime with your fingers (but you can cover a part of a card with your fingers)









The other players can make **as many suggestions as they like**, as soon as the first card has been placed. The first player who guesses the enigma and the player who placed the cards both win 1 point: they take a 1 token in front of them.

• If several players give the correct answer at **exactly** the same time, they each win 1 point.









There is no time limit. If nobody guesses the enigma after a period of time decided by the players, then the round ends and nobody wins a point.

Next turn

The used **transparent cards** are put back in the circle. Then it is the next player's turn (clockwise) to get the players to guess a new enigma.

* END OF THE GAME

The game ends when each player has managed to get the other players to guess 2 enigmas. The player who accumulates the highest number of points is the winner. If there is a tie, you have to play one more game!

Once you have played a few times, you can get the other players to guess an enigma of your own creation instead of taking a card. When it is your turn, provide a relevant clue (film, character, object...) and you are off to the races!

You can also personalize your enigmas with your common interests (works of art, book titles, video games...) or more personal themes such as "Chloe's favourite toy", your holiday destination or "my mother-in-law"...

Make sure you pick something that all the players know about!







✓ You can do ANYTHING with the transparent cards, but...

- You are not allowed to speak, make noises or sing ...
- You are not allowed to mime with your hands, only with the cards!
- You are not allowed to make letters or digits with the cards, stick with your imagination!



तं YES, YES, you can:

- Use AS MANY CARDS as you wish
- Put the cards together, put them on top of each other, combine them and MOVE them.
- Hide parts of the cards with your fingers,
- Make 3D models of the cards by lifting them up from the table but don't get carried away miming with your fingers!
- * Please notice there are both Chinese & English enigma on the cards, but considering cultural differences, the meanings between them might not be the same.
